#### **Greetings Church!**

I am excited! I am excited to be here and get to know you. I am excited to hear about the legacy and the people that established and handed on this church through the generations. I am excited to take part in the impactful ministries that are already happening. And I'm excited to see where God will lead us in the season ahead!

On my first Sunday in worship, I was so touched by the music and the beauty of worship. Attending Kairos kitchen, I was humbled to see that the welcome my family received was also extended to our unhoused neighbors. The heart of Christ is so evident in the ways you welcome all people into your church home and life. Within these two simple events, you have captured the core purpose of church - in worship, we gather to remember and tell our story; and then we go out to put that story into action. I can't wait to explore ways that we can expand on our efforts to love this City more fully.

A few of the things occupying my first month:

- 1) Conversations I've talked with a variety of new and longtime members and will continue to do so as often as possible. I love to hear your stories and to get a sense of what this church and its ministries have meant to you. - 2) Reviewing bills and budgets money isn't the goal of what we do, but being good stewards of the gifts you offer is vitally important so that we can maximize the impact of our resources. We're reviewing everything to ensure it makes sense for who we are now and where we want to go from here. Our finance team is finalizing plans for greater financial transparency and keeping you up to date.
- 3) Pushing forward it is clear that this church has been talking about what's next for a while and is primed to start moving toward the future God has in store for you. I've asked the Church Council to develop a plan with me in the next couple of months to prioritize where you want me to focus and how quickly you're ready to move. Concretely, we'll follow up on the World Cafe conversations and revisit the committee adjustments that began this year. In August, look for more from the Council on next steps.

Above all else, in the season ahead we hope to lay a strong foundation for what God will do through this church for generations to come. Some of that work will be exciting and joyful. Some of it may be challenging and uncomfortable. Through it all, my prayer is that we would trust more and more in what God has in store for us and that we would boldly follow where God leads.
