FORMING CONFIRMATION CLASSES

We are planning for confirmation classes to begin this summer or in the fall. Confirmation will be for students in the 6th grade or older. A NOTE FROM RUBY NELSON

Before I started preaching, I was a case manager with the Texas Department of Human Services. My job was to encourage welfare recipients to go to work, or to school, or whatever it took to become self-sufficient instead of welfare dependent. One of the main obstacles was lack of dependable child care. Have you checked the price of child care recently? Wow !!!!!!

When I came to FUMC, I was thrilled to learn that a subsidized child care center operates within this building. That means that most of the parents are in school or working and pay according to their income. Thus they have an opportunity to make a home for their family, and a future for their children

Every Sunday, we end our worship service with "We will go out to be God's people, to love this city with the heart of Christ."

Can you think of a better way to love this city than to assure parents that their children are well cared for as the parents go out to work or in school? That is what Once Upon A Dream Center does. I am proud to be part of a United Methodist Church that helps that to happen.

BIOGRAPHY

Established by pianists and Lamar University faculty, Sujung Cho and Jacob Clark, Duo Korusa is a versatile piano duo/duet team dedicated to the performance of lesser-known works of the 19th and 20th century, as well as new works of the 21st century. Since its inception in 2012, Duo Korusa has been performing rare or newly composed piano duet works throughout the United States. Equally academics and performers, both members of Duo Korusa have a keen interest in research and have presented lecture recitals at national and regional conferences of the College Music Society as well as at the National Group Piano and Piano Pedagogy Conference. Awarded a grant from Lamar University's College of Fine Arts and Communication, Duo Korusa used this funding to record the piano duet works of Marie Jaell and Jane Savage and the resulting album was released digitally and physically by Centaur Records in March of 2023. A second grant from the Center for Resiliency awarded for 2023 has resulted in a community outreach tour and will culminate in another recording featuring the complete works of Beethoven for piano duet also to be released on the Centaur label.
